

On the need for sustained military and political support for Ukraine

Recalls that:

- the inaugural Summit on Peace in Ukraine in Switzerland on 15-16 June 2024 received unprecedented support from 101 states and international organisations from all continents and regions worldwide;
- the final communiqué of the Peace Summit, which sets out the vision of the three points of Ukraine's Peace Formula, namely nuclear and food security, release of prisoners of war and civilians, was immediately supported by 84 participants of the Summit;
- Russia has intensified shelling of Ukraine's critical infrastructure, which has led to an acute situation in the country's energy sector;
- Russia has abducted and deported about 20 thousand Ukrainian children, in response to which PACE called on to recognise this as a war crime;
- the decision of the G7 countries to provide Ukraine with a \$50 billion loan to be repaid with revenues from frozen Russian assets laid the foundation for further use of these assets to support Ukraine.

Believes that:

- Ukraine's Peace Formula is the only way to a just and lasting peace in Ukraine;
- sustainable military support for Ukraine is the key to Ukraine's victory over Russia;
- sanctions against the aggressor have to be further strengthened and fully implemented.

Calls for:

- support for the full implementation of Ukraine's Peace Formula and its individual points as a precondition to European security;
- taking steps to increase military support for Ukraine and accelerate the terms of the respective supplies;
- depriving Russia of its tools to wage war by strengthening sanctions, including targeted sanctions on its shadow fleet, export controls and counteracting their circumvention;
- seeking all legal ways in which Russia's frozen assets can be fully used for Ukraine's purposes;
- facilitating international cooperation for the return of Ukrainian children and signing up to the existed and to be established agreements.
