

Freedom to Vladimir Kara-Murza and Ilya Yashin and all Russian political prisoners. Peace for the world and freedom to all those striving for peace!

Notes that:

- it was reported on 19 June that Russian authorities have toughened even more the conditions of imprisonment for Vladimir Kara-Murza, Russian political prisoner, journalist, liberal opposition politician and Liberal International Prize for Freedom winner, transferring him to a cell with toughened conditions. A day before Ilya Yashin, another imprisoned Russian opposition politician, was transferred to the same type of cell after being kept in a punitive confinement;
- such conditions must be regarded as torture, and bordering on killing for a very ill Kara-Murza.

Calls on:

- the international community to intensify the efforts to urgently seek freedom for Kara-Murza, who may not survive such toughening of the regime due to his health, Ilya Yashin and all other sick Russian political prisoners like Alexei Gorinov and Alexandra Skochilenko;
- the democratic states and human rights defenders to spare no effort to save the lives of the brave and honest dissenting who are being tortured and slowly killed in Russian prisons because of their strive for peace and democracy, their efforts to stop war, such people must be saved, there is no excuse for slacking the efforts because of their nationality as kindness and humanism has no nationality or borders, as every such death observed idly brings the humanity closer to the abyss;
- demand from the Russian Federation to free all political prisoners and all prisoners of war.
