5 Acknowledges that:

- Bulgaria and Romania have met all legal and operational conditions and criteria
 for accession to the Schengen Area since 2011. However, the unjustified veto of
 some member states has prevented them from joining the border-free area;
- the ALDE Party, Renew Europe, the European Parliament, and the European
 Commission have all expressed their firm support for the accession of Bulgaria
 and Romania to Schengen. the Commission President insisted in the State of the
 Union 2023 address that Bulgaria and Romania should be admitted into the
 Schengen Area without further delay;
- on 15 September 2023, the European Commission announced that it formally closed
 the Cooperation and Verification Mechanism for Bulgaria and Romania, often cited
 as a prerequisite for lifting the veto, concluding that both countries had
 satisfactorily met their judicial and anti-corruption reform obligations;
- the accession of Bulgaria and Romania to the Schengen Area would strengthen the
 EU's external borders, improve cooperation between law enforcement agencies, and
 boost economic growth and trade. It would also be a powerful symbol of European
 unity and solidarity;

• the unjustified veto against Bulgaria and Romania's accession to the Schengen 26 Area has many negative consequences: it violates the principle of law-based 27 decisions, thereby harming the reputation of the European Union in accession 28 countries, feeds into populist anti-EU propaganda, discriminates against 29 citizens and businesses, and raises the cost of trade. It also hinders economic 30 growth and increases CO2 emissions, estimated at 46,000 tonnes annually with the 31 lengthy queues at the border crossing points between Greece, Bulgaria, Romania, 32 and Hungary. 33

34 Calls for:

- the Council's Spanish presidency to treat the matter with urgency and schedule a vote on the matter before the end of 2023;
- All Member states to lift the veto without delay;
- ALDE Member parties to continue to publicly express their support and push for the Schengen accession of Bulgaria and Romania.
